This is a part-time role, with flexible hours, working from home.

Priorities for you in this role will be to

- Support landowners to design and implement collective projects
- Support the water monitoring programme and ensure that it is relevant to landowners
- Identify future projects that farmer groups and the wider community wish to undertake and how to resource them
- Foster relationships between mana whenua and the wider community

You will also

- Organise workshops, courses and expert-led sessions that meet landowner and community needs
- Get relevant information and news out to and from the community (in newsletters and on social media)
- · Feed what you're seeing and hearing in the community into future planning

We are looking for someone who is

- Good at listening and talking to farmers, hapū and other community members
- Self-motivated, well-organised and good at managing your time effectively
- · Skilled in planning and getting things done to support landowner-driven projects
- Open-minded to different perspectives and ways of doing things
- Good with Microsoft Word and Excel
- Experienced in organising events such as workshops and courses
- Flexible with hours, and able to work outside normal business hours if required
- Collegial and professional in a small team

Experience working with rural communities and familiarity with the issues facing the primary industry and the B2R area would all be advantages.
